This course is designed for the forestry industry and meets the requirements for the Forest Industry Safety Accord (FISA).

The finer details

Our two-day course offers a balanced mix of theory and practical sessions.

There are five modules in all.



The first covers safety, health and welfare and is mandatory. It must be completed before the other modules.

We will, however, accept equivalent health and safety certification if it has been completed within five years of this refresher course.



Examples of equivalent certification include:

- IOSH (Managing Safely)
- NEBOSH Certificate
- Lantra Awards Health & Safety and Practical Risk Assessment
- Construction Skills Health and Safety equivalent to 5 days training
- BSC level 3 Occupational Safety or above
- Level 3 Award in Controlling Risks to Health & Safety in Agriculture and Production Horticulture (QCF).

Worth noting: You will need a minimum level of fitness to complete this course.
